- Entries will be managed at the Show Office on Saturday (28th March 2026) from 8:15am.
- All dogs not competing **MUST** be on a lead with a handler, in the marshalling area behind the competition area **AT ALL TIMES**.
- Only **ONE** dog may be loose within the competition area at any given time.
- There **MUST** be a handler at the top of the jump to act as a catcher if necessary, & a handler at the bottom as the 'catcher' as well. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to supply their extra handlers.
- Each dog is **ALLOWED** three attempts at each height if necessary.
- In the event where two dogs are jumping at the same height, the winner shall be determined by the dog that took the **LEAST NUMBER** of attempts from one jump.
- A dog may be able to compete on a loose lead, or, must be released at a minimum of **THREE METRES** from the jump. If, in the opinion of the Stewards, believe that a dog is unsafe to other dogs, handlers & the general public, it will be withdrawn from the competition **IMMEDIATELY**.
- **WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE, PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF COMPETITION**

## **IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER:**

- The breed, shape, sex & colour of the dog are **NOT** taken into account.
- Muzzles may be worn.
- Any mishandling and/or misuse of a dog will result in **IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION**.
- All competing dogs must have been vaccinated against canine distemper, canine infectious hepatitis, & canine parvo virus within the previous 12 months, but no later than 2 weeks prior to competition. – A certificate must be presented if requested by the convenor.
